
Introduction:

This chart presents the minimum and maximum tuition fees for higher education in various countries. It helps students plan their education budget.




~ **The USA** has the highest tuition fees (₹18–46 Lakh).

This graph compares monthly living costs for students in different countries. It includes rent, food, transportation, and other essential expenses.




~ **Switzerland, the USA, and Singapore** are the most expensive places to live.

Visa success is critical for students planning to study abroad. This chart illustrates the likelihood of Indian students securing a study visa in various countries.




~ **Italy, Spain, UK, Ireland, Australia, Denmark** have high visa success rates (~95–98%).

This graph displays the number of hours students are permitted to work per week while studying. Part-time work helps support living costs and gain experience.




Spain allows the maximum hours (30 hours/week).

This graph shows the number of years international students can stay and work after completing their studies in different countries. Longer PSW durations provide more opportunities to gain work experience and apply for permanent residency.




~ **USA, Canada, Australia, and Denmark** allow the longest PSW duration (3 years).

~ **Switzerland** offers the highest post-graduation salaries.
